

## Check Belt Tightness

Hold at the Forward-Facing Belt Path.

Push and pull from side to side.

It should not move more than 1 in. $(2.5 \mathrm{~cm})$.

## . WARNING

This Quick Start Guide is set up to help you get started installing either the 1st or 2nd mode: Rear-Facing or Forward-Facing.

For Booster Seat mode and other information about choosing car seat modes, please read the full instruction manual.

REAR-FACING MODE
4-40 lb (1.8-18 kg)
and 19-40 in. (48-101.6 cm)
```

Children under 1 year of age must ride Rear-Facing.
In this car seat, your child can remain Rear-Facing until they outgrow any one of the following:

- Weight Limit: $40 \mathrm{lb}(18 \mathrm{~kg}) ;$ OR
- Height Limit: 40 in. ( 101.6 cm ); OR
- Rear-Facing child fit requirements. See page 11 of manual.


## FORWARD-FACING MODE

22-65 lb (10.1-29 kg)
and 29-49 in. (73.6-125 cm)
Children must be at least 1 year of age to ride Forward-Facing.
In this car seat, your child can remain harnessed Forward-Facing until they outgrow any one of the following:

- Weight Limit: $65 \mathrm{lb}(29 \mathrm{~kg})$; OR
- Height Limit: 49 in. ( 125 cm ); OR
- Forward-Facing child fit requirements. See page 12 of manual.

There are 2 methods for install. Choose only one:


Vehicle Belt


LATCH:
Lower Anchor Belt
$\triangle$ Do not use both the LATCH: lower anchor belt and vehicle belt at the same time. When used correctly, the LATCH: lower anchor belt or vehicle belts are equally safe.


Place Car Seat RearFacing in Back Seat

. Never install a rear-facing child restraint in the front seat of a vehicle equipped with an active frontal airbag.


Fully Recline Car Seat

Recline handle on front of seat and under pad.

Tighten Belt

Recheck Rear-Facing Level Line

Redo the installation if the car seat is not reclined correctly for your child.

Check the tightness of the install often.

## 7 Forward-Facing Vehicle Install

There are 2 methods for install. Choose only one:

Vehicle Belt + Tether
up to $65 \mathrm{lb}(29 \mathrm{~kg})$
OR
LATCH: Lower Anchor Belt + Tether up to $40 \mathrm{lb}(18 \mathrm{~kg})$
. Do not use both the LATCH: lower anchor belt and vehicle belt at the same time. When used correctly, the LATCH: lower anchor belt or vehicle belts are equally safe.


Place Car Seat Forward-Facing in Back Seat
Put the child restraint into Position 1.
Vehicle seat back must be upright.


If your vehicle has a headrest that interferes with a flush car seat fit, check your vehicle owner's manual to see if it can be removed, adjusted, or if there are other possible seating locations for you to install.
